\$10 per barley card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Alaska Grown beef in demand. **All** beef cattle farmers benefit.

\$10 per beef cattle card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Your new breeding stock produces well.

\$10 per livestock commodity card, up to \$40, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Your llama ewes had triplet crias.

\$10 per llama card for you.

GOOD NEWS: Good Alaska wool is in demand. **All** sheep owners benefit.

\$10 per sheep card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Your mutton is popular in restaurants.

\$10 per sheep card for you.

GOOD NEWS: The experimental variety you planted has high yield.

\$10 per crop card for you.

GOOD NEWS: Bad hay crop in Canada raises prices here. **All** hay farmers benefit.

\$10 per hay crop card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Alaska llama wool is in demand. **All** llama owners benefit.

\$10 per llama card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Your Hereford (beef) bull is grand champion at fair.

\$10 for one beef card for you.

GOOD NEWS: Good weather helps your barley crop.

\$10 for each barley card for you.

GOOD NEWS: Mild winter cuts energy costs.

\$10 for each livestock card, except aquaculture for you.

BAD NEWS: Your animals had poor weight gain because of poor pasture. Lose \$10 for each livestock card, except aquaculture, for you.

BAD NEWS: Rains prevented a second cutting of hay.

lose \$10 for each hay card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Bison trampled an entire newly planted field.

lose \$10 for any one hay or grain field, for you.

BAD NEWS: Cheap beef floods Alaska's markets.

lose \$10 for each beef card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Fuel costs rise.

lose \$10 for each animal card and each produce card, up to \$50, for you.

BAD NEWS: Blight ravages your potatoes.

lose \$20 for each potato card for you.

BAD NEWS: Fast-moving storm kills many young lambs.

lose \$20 for each sheep card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Lack of snow and bitter cold cause winter kill in hay fields.
lose \$10 for each hay card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Mold hits your barley crop.
lose \$10 for each barley card, for you.

BAD NEWS: No market for wool.
lose \$10 for each sheep card and \$20 for each llama card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Neighbor files lawsuit against farming noise and smell. Lose half your money.

BAD NEWS: Interest rates go up. **All** Alaskans affected.
lose \$10 for each card, up to \$50, for everyone.

BAD NEWS: You are injured in farm-equipment accident.
lose half your money.

GOOD NEWS: Gas prices are down. **All** carrot, potato, miscellaneous vegetable and hay producers benefit.
\$10 for each carrot, potato, miscellaneous vegetable and hay card, for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: You buy an irrigation system cheap from a neighbor.
\$10 total, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Alaska Grown marketing program benefits **all** potato growers.
\$10 per potato card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Your farm is well known. Earn a premium on every product.
\$10 per card (up to \$60), for you.

GOOD NEWS: Someone in your family gets a good job off the farm.
\$50 total, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Mining company wants to lease some of your land. \$10 total, for you.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: Research shows bison meat healthier than beef. **All** bison ranchers affected.
\$10 for each bison card; lose \$10 for each beef card, for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Agricultural education in schools promotes Alaska products. Affects **all players**.
\$10 total for **every player**.

GOOD NEWS: Spraying program eliminates noxious weeds in your barley.
\$10 for each barley card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Careful fertilization program increases yields, not costs.
\$10 for each field crop (does not include greenhouse) card for you.

GOOD NEWS: Lower fuel costs save your greenhouse expenses.
\$10 for each greenhouse crop card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: New solar collector saves your greenhouse energy costs.

\$10 for each greenhouse crop card for you.

GOOD NEWS: President says he only eats Alaska potatoes; affects **all** potato growers.

\$10 for each potato card for everyone.

BAD NEWS: Moose trample your miscellaneous vegetable and carrot crops.

lose \$10 for each misc. vegetable or carrot card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Neighbors cows get into your potato field.

Lose \$10 for each potato card for you, **IF** the person on either side of you has dairy or beef cows.

BAD NEWS: Invasive weeds infest your hay fields.

Lose \$10 for each hay card for you, **AND** either neighbor loses \$10 if he or she has any hay card.

BAD NEWS: Neighbor kids run their four-wheeler in your newly planted field.

Lose \$10 for any one crop card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Cheap milk floods Alaska market; affects **all** dairy farmers..

Lose \$10 for each dairy cattle card, for everyone.

BAD NEWS: Unscrupulous livestock hauler brings swine disease in from Lower 48.

Lose \$10 for each swine card for you, **AND** either neighbor loses \$10 for each swine card, too.

BAD NEWS: Taxes on your land go up.

Lose \$20 total for you.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: Shortage of feed means grain prices rise.

\$10 for each barley card **or** lose \$10 for each livestock card for you.

BAD NEWS: Your crops hit by grasshoppers.

lose \$10 for each crop (not greenhouse) for you.

BAD NEWS: Mold infests your greenhouse operation.

lose \$20 for first greenhouse card and \$10 for any others for you..

BAD NEWS: Dry weather cuts your yields.

lose \$10 for each grain, potato and carrot card for you.

BAD NEWS: Bacteria levels high in milk from your parlor.

lose \$10 for each dairy card for you.

GOOD NEWS: New processing facility opens for your vegetables.

\$10 for each vegetable card (carrot, potato, misc. veg.), up to \$40 for you.

BAD NEWS: Well on your farm goes dry; no irrigation for your crops.

lose \$10 each for hay, potatoes, carrots or misc. veg. (\$20 total), for you.

BAD NEWS: Wolves attack your sheep and llamas.

lose \$10 for each sheep or llama card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Dairy processing facility closes. Affects **all** dairy farmers.

lose \$10 for each dairy card for everyone.

BAD NEWS: Slaughterhouse shuts its doors.

lose \$10 for each livestock card, up to \$40 for you.

GOOD NEWS: Disease-resistant plant variety a success.

\$10 for each crop card, up to \$50 for you.

GOOD NEWS: Dock workers strike in Seattle raises demand for Alaska Grown foods. Affects **all**.

\$10 for each crop or animal card up to \$30 for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: You earn a premium on your greenhouse products.

\$10 for each greenhouse card for you.

GOOD NEWS: You are recognized as Alaska's producer of the year.

\$10 total for you.

GOOD NEWS: More horses in Alaska mean more markets for hay. **All** hay farmers benefit.

\$10 for each hay card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Politicians cut red tape hampering **all** Alaska farmers.

\$10 total for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Your crop insurance pays off.

\$10 for each barley and hay card for you.

GOOD NEWS: Neighbor brings back the equipment he borrowed.

\$10 total for you.

GOOD NEWS: New government program provides you assistance.

\$10 total for you.

BAD NEWS: Beetles cause silver top disease in your grass seed crop.

Lose \$10 for each grass seed card for you.

BAD NEWS: Early frost kills your vegetables.

Lose \$10 for each potato, carrot or misc. vegetable card for you.

BAD NEWS: Wet spring delays planting.

Lose \$10 for each crop card (not greenhouse), up to \$50, for you.

BAD NEWS: Mild winter allows insects to thrive.

Lose \$10 for each crop card, including greenhouse, up to \$40, for you.

BAD NEWS: Cows in your herd get mastitis.

Lose \$10 for each dairy herd card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your reindeer run off with wild caribou herd. Lose \$10 for each reindeer card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Oil spill threatens your aquaculture farm.
Lose \$10 for each aquaculture card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Research shows farmed oysters healthier than wild.
\$10 for each aquaculture card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Government reduces red tape on meat production.
\$10 for each livestock or aquaculture card, up to \$40, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Governor promoted Alaska aquaculture to new market.
\$10 for each aquaculture card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Fishermen protest Alaska aquaculture.
lose \$10 for each aquaculture card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Alaska Grown promotion benefits one of your crops. Affects **all** farmers of one crop of **your** choosing. \$10 for each card of that crop for you AND **everyone** else with that one crop.

GOOD NEWS: You work to open new markets in Far East. \$20 each card of one commodity for you and \$10 apiece for any **other** players with that commodity.

GOOD NEWS: Your new blue potato is success as potato chip.
\$10 for each potato card for you.

GOOD NEWS: New dairy product sweeps the market; benefits **all** dairy farmers.
\$10 for each dairy card for each player.

GOOD NEWS: New tax code helps save you money.
\$10 total, for you.

BAD NEWS: Strong winds damage your greenhouses.
lose \$10 for each greenhouse card, for you.
BAD NEWS: Hail ruins your vegetable crops.
lose \$10 for each potato, carrot or misc. vegetable card, up to \$40, for you.

BAD NEWS: Flooding ruins your fields.
lose \$10 for each barley, hay or grass seed field, up to \$30, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your tractor must be replaced.
lose \$10 total, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your best milk cow dies while calving.
lose \$10 total for any dairy cow card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Bear mauls your bison.
lose \$10 for each bison card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Snowmachiners damage your hay fields.
lose \$10 for each hay card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Price of fertilizer goes up.
lose \$10 for any hay or grass-seed field, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your sheep won't gain weight.
lose \$10 for each sheep card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Negative news stories drive down demand for pork. Affects **all** hog farmers.
lose \$10 per hog card for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Alaska Grown label recognized in California. Affects **all**.
\$10 for each player, total.

GOOD NEWS: New value-added products a success at grocery stores.
\$10 for each miscellaneous vegetable card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Wind knocks down your crops.
lose \$10 for each barley, grass seed or hay card, up to \$50, for you.

GOOD NEWS: New breeding stock is a good investment.
\$10 for each livestock card, up to \$50, for you.

BAD NEWS: Local government raises your taxes.
lose \$10 for each card, up to \$60, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your animals starve on poor food.
lose \$10 for each sheep, llama, beef cattle or dairy cow card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Market up for your reindeer velvet and byproducts.
lose \$10 for each reindeer card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Demand high for your rent-a-reindeer.
\$10 for each reindeer card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your reindeer need special hay ration.
lose \$10 for each reindeer card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Insects infest local vegetable crops.
lose \$10 for each miscellaneous vegetable crop card for you; each of your **neighbors** with a misc. veg crop card loses \$10 total.

GOOD NEWS: You strike a deal to ship pork to China.
\$20 for each hog card for you.

BAD NEWS: Your sheep lose their wool because of vitamin deficiency.
lose \$10 for each sheep card for you.

BAD NEWS: Your milking machine needs replacing.
lose \$20 total if you have a dairy cow card, for you..

BAD NEWS: Barn damaged in high wind.
lose \$20 total for you.

BAD NEWS: Blizzard kills your beef cattle.
lose \$20 for each beef card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Sow crushes seven of your piglets.
lose \$10 if you have one or more hog cards, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your livestock break down a wall in the barn and smash your computer.
lose \$10 total if you have any livestock card, for you.

BAD NEWS: You have to go to court over a land dispute.
lose \$20 total, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your truck must be replaced.
lose \$20 total, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Interest rates go down. Affects **all**.
\$10 for each card, any commodity, up to \$60. Everyone.

BAD NEWS: Rootworms infest your carrots.
lose \$10 for each carrot card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Cold spring hurts germination
lose \$10 for each potato, carrot, misc. vegetable card, for you.

BAD NEWS: New variety you try is a failure.
lose \$10 total if you have any crop cards, for you.

BAD NEWS: You break your arm and have to hire help.
lose \$10, and **give** it to another player.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: You have offer to sell your field for a good price.
\$30 if you have a hay, barley or potato card and you sell, but you lose that card. You may choose not to sell the land, and will lose and gain nothing.

GOOD NEWS: High unemployment rate means cheap summer labor for your farm.
\$10 each for any hay, carrot or potato card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Neighbor pays off debt to you with livestock.
take one livestock card from player on your left **or** right.

BAD NEWS: Bison gores you.
lose \$20 if you have a bison card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Hoof and mouth disease scare ruins meat market. **All** hog, beef, sheep, bison and reindeer farmers affected.
lose \$10 for each hog, beef, sheep, bison or reindeer card, up to \$60. Everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Mad Cow Disease scare in the Lower 48 makes Alaska dairy cows more valuable. **All** dairy farmers affected.
\$10 for each dairy cow card, everyone.

GOOD NEWS: Tissue culture propagation of vegetables has improved your stock.
\$10 for each potato, carrot, miscellaneous vegetable or greenhouse crop card, for you, up to \$50.

GOOD NEWS: Oyster bar wants you to be sole supplier.
\$10 for each aquaculture card, for you.

BAD NEWS Herd breaks down fence and some animals hit on the highway.
lose \$10 for each beef, dairy cow, reindeer, bison or llama/alpaca card, up to \$30, for you.

BAD NEWS: Neighbor s inferior crops cross pollinate with yours.
lose \$10 if you **and** either of your neighbors has a Greenhouse Crops card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: More money goes into advertising Alaska Grown. **All** beef cattle, dairy cow, sheep, hog, carrots, potatoes, misc. vegetable, aquaculture and greenhouse vegetable farmers benefit.
\$10 for each of those crops up to \$30, for everyone.

GOOD NEWS: A farmer leaving Alaska gives you his sheep herd.
take a sheep card from the player to your left. If he or she does not have one, ask each player to your left, going clockwise, until you obtain one sheep card. If no one has a sheep card, you get nothing.

BAD NEWS: Neighbor s bull breaks down your fence.
lose \$10 if either of your neighbors have a dairy, beef or bison card, for you.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: Warm winter means your animals are healthy but your fields are infected with insects in the spring.
\$10 for every livestock card (except aquaculture) up to \$40, and lose \$10 per crop card up to \$40, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Your woodlot has valuable trees.
\$10 total.

GOOD NEWS: Cover crops reduce your soil erosion.
\$10 for each field crop (potatoes, misc. vegetables, carrots, barley), for you, up to \$30.

BAD NEWS: Neighbor s poor disking practices causes siltation on your fields.
lose \$10 for any crop except greenhouse, for you, up to \$30.

BAD NEWS: You break your arm and have to hire help.
lose \$10, and **give** it to another player.

GOOD NEWS: Your farm is used for a commercial.
\$20 total, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Your sow is a grand champion at the fair.
\$10 if you have one or more hog cards, for you.

GOOD NEWS: You get a good interest rate on a new loan.
\$20 total for you.

GOOD NEWS: Local stables buying all its hay from you.
\$10 for each hay card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Mining company needs your grass seed for a reclamation project.
\$20 for each grass seed card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Llama and alpaca hiking trips becoming popular. Your animals are in demand.
\$10 for each llama/alpaca card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Global warming threatens your aquaculture operation.
lose \$20 for each aquaculture card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Your grass field is invaded by broadleaf weeds.
lose \$10 for each grass seed card., for you.

GOOD NEWS: Your dairy herd gives a record amount of milk and butterfat.
\$10 for each dairy cow card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Cheaper bedding material available for your animals.
\$10 for each dairy, beef, hog, sheep, llama/alpaca card, for you, up to \$30.

GOOD NEWS: You get two weeks of dry weather during hay baling time.
\$10 for each hay card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: New strain of barley resists molds.
\$10 for each barley card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Otters get into your oyster beds.

\$10 for each aquaculture card, for you.

GOOD NEWS: Good summer rains means potatoes aren't bitter.

\$10 for each potato card, for you.

BAD NEWS: Baler breaks down during prime haying season.

\$10 for each hay card, up to \$20, for you.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: Trade one of your commodity cards with another player. You may CHOOSE which card you wish to trade and you will DRAW a card from his or her hand. That player cannot choose which card you take.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: Trade one commodity card with any other player. Both of you will draw from the other player without looking at the card.

GOOD NEWS/BAD NEWS: Everyone take one commodity card of your choice, lay it face down and slide it to the player to your left. Each player picks up his or her new card and places it in his or her hand. Every player should have one new card.
